ESSHL POLICY FOR LATE SIGN UPS

- 1. After the draft, a player shall be considered "signed up" when his completed forms and money have been received by the treasurer.
- 2. Beginning on the last day of September, on the last day of each month, a drawing will be held to assign late sign-ups to teams. The final deadline will be December 31.
- 3. Each coach will be contacted by the Street Hockey director and asked if they need any new players. Teams with less than 10 players on the roster cannot refuse players.
- 4. All new players' names will be written on tickets and placed in a hat. All drawings will be conducted by the treasurer. The teams needing the greatest number of players will be drawn for first. If the number of players needed exceeds the number of players available, enough blank tickets will be placed in the hat along with the available player's names to complete one round of drawings.
- 5. Any players wishing to sign up after the December 31, or coaches seeking new players after December 31 will be asked to present their case to the board and prove special circumstances, such as a team with less than 6 players. The board will then decide by majority vote.
- 6. Coaches will not be told the names of the available players, or the number of players available.
- 7. If a player signs up but never plays or receives a jersey, the player's money will be refunded.
- 8. There will be no late yokes
- 9. A player who misses 6 consecutive games is to be taken off the roster unless there are special circumstances recognized by the board
